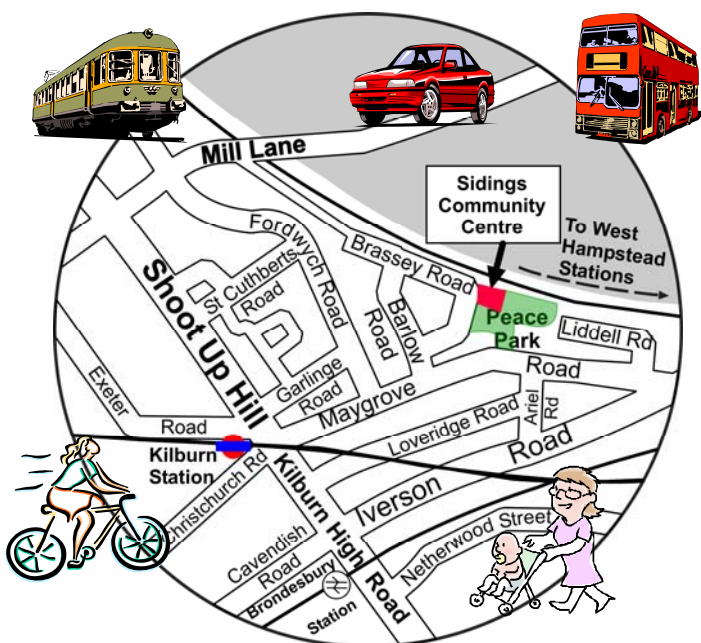


Our play schemes are very popular and always oversubscribed. Priority will be given to Camden residents and our After School Club members.
